Dear Area,

My trip to region was a success. Region passed all the proposed re-wording of the guidelines to bring things more up to date with the times, and clarify parts of the guidelines that were a little too vague. The RD was grateful that we brought in some of the surveys they asked us to fill out and stated that the answers along with others that were turned in would go to WSO for further review.

- a. Current discussions at region centered around having the Plain States Zone host a BMLT Server. For those that don't know what that is it is a Basic Meeting List Template Server. It would help coordinate all of our meeting lists at the world level and below. Our IT person would then have access to the template for the meeting lists to go in and make changes to our areas meetings individually. This would help keep the meeting list updated, and this information sync's with NAWS directly so individuals could download the app that NAWS has on their website for your phones to get a current meeting list anywhere anytime. That will help cut down on the number of people showing up to meetings that are no longer running or have incorrect addresses etc. It's basically an updateable tool to help keep our meeting lists current for every addict around the world. At region everyone who spoke about this thought it was a great idea. Brian gave a great presentation before region on how it works along with Barry B. and I personally think it's a good idea to keep our meeting lists current so addicts don't show up to meetings that are closed or moved. This discussion has turned into a proposal that is going back to your groups. You can read this part of my report and ask your groups if they like the idea and bring me back and answer at the next area please. That way we can take our consensus about this back to region.
- b. Also we have been asked to decide on a motion that was put forth by the world board. They would like to send a zonal representative to the world service Conference along with the RD/RDA to help ensure that every region has representation at the WSC. They will not have a vote but just discussion abilities. Each individual region would be responsible for the cost of sending the extra person. Intent: To provide a regional representative so that all regions are represented and no one region is left out of the process.

The region didn't have a lot of other things to discuss mostly it was bill paying and some discussion about how close encounters went. Bills are current and paid at the regional level. And things are well. They are excited to see how SBTW project is moving along and wanting to see the progress. I provided them with current SBTW flyers and I also brought back a ton of flyers for this area to take with you so please don't forget to get them off the table.
