to seat zonally instead of regionally because of the cost per seat.. They want us at the next region to tell them if its ok to investigate how

this would work and what it would save in the long run. The Zone posed a question: They would like to see if our area would support the

Zone holding funds back from their donation to World in order to continue funding project that they already have in the works.

This would mean not automatically forwarding all the funds they take into world and then having to fundraise for what they need later.

We are supposed to send in our answer at the next region because it will change policy..

There is one proposal from the region that we must vote on. The H&I chair would like to increase her subcommittees budget from 450 dollars

per quarter to 600 dollars per quarter. So the proposal reads as follows: To increase the Regional H&I budget from \$450.00 to \$600.00 per

quarter. Intent: to avoid shipping fees of \$50.00 that are charged on any order under \$500.00 because at \$500.00 or more you get free

shipping. Region treasurer says we have the funds and they

can be spent. does it change policy?---yes. Bring back your vote at next area.
