The file has been submitted to the executive committee and we will review in January the final will be available at the February ASC. Regarding Article X, Section 2, Items A and F • I would like to bring to the GSR's attention that the Vice Chairperson of area is a signer on the ENNASC bank account and is required to assume the duties of Treasurer in the absence of both the Treasurer and Vice Treasurer. The Vice Chairperson is required to have 2 years clean and yet the treasurer is required to have 3 years. The vice treasurer also has a 2 year clean time requirement. It is my job as policy chair to only bring this to your attention for discussion as a possible policy change to the clean time requirement of Vice Chairpersons and Vice Treasurer. It's the GSR's responsibility to bring motions to the ASC that change policy of the guidelines.
