WHAT IS VENMO AND HOW CAN IT BENEFIT YOUR GROUPS?

OVERVIEW

Description: Venmo is one of the most popular apps in the “peer-to-peer” (P2P) payments space. By linking a credit card, debit card or checking account to their Venmo account, Venmo users can exchange funds with each other, and send each other charges. Funds exchanged on Venmo can either be stored in the on-platform Venmo balance for later use on the platform, or cashed out to a bank account, which takes a few days to process. Venmo has an application programming interface that allows websites and businesses to add Venmo to their payment services.

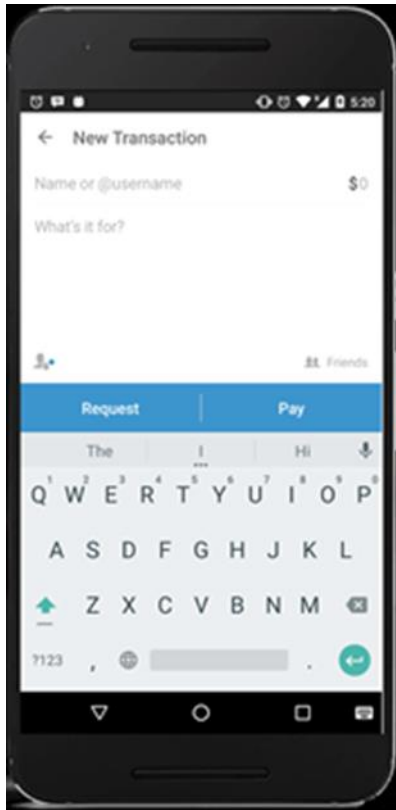
Venmo can be understood as a middleman between the bank accounts of its users. When you use Venmo to send money to a friend, it doesn't go directly to your friend's bank account. First, it goes to Venmo. The app then lowers your Venmo balance and raises your friend's balance to reflect the payment. However, the money doesn't actually leave your bank account until your friend transfers his Venmo balance to his bank account. This means that you and your friend can send money back and forth on Venmo without either of your bank account balances ever actually changing - only your Venmo balances will. So, a user's Venmo balance is a ledger that only represents funds and transactions, without actually executing them outside of Venmo's platform. Generally speaking, your balance on Venmo is essentially “fake” money - until it is transferred to a bank, it isn't actually in the possession of the user.

1. So simply here's how it works “YOU” the user download Venmo from your app market on your smartphone or go to their website, sign up for a free Venmo account with a few clicks on your keyboard and you are ready to start paying your 7th tradition with an app so you do not need to carry cash. The payments can be made from your smart phone or a computer. You simply link your form of payment to your Venmo account and use that form of payment to send your 7th tradition to your homegroup.
2. The Homegroup signs up for Venmo by the treasurer downloading an app to their smartphone or going to the Venmo website. They link the groups bank account to their Venmo account. Your payments come into their Venmo account from your Venmo account and it sits there for fees of \$0.00 until they cash it out to their bank costing a max fee of \$10.00.
3. The Area treasurer signs up for a Venmo account, and your Homegroup takes the funds in their Venmo account and makes an area donation straight from Venmo. Still no fees involved. The area treasurer deposits the funds into the Area bank account for a maximum \$10.00 fee.

So example: I sign up for Venmo. I transfer \$20 dollars a month to my Homegroup. The homegroup sends that money to their bank account the night of their business meeting. The treasurer of that homegroup checks the bank account balance and writes a check to area for the amount they are donating. It costs the group a max fee of \$10.00

Or I sign up for Venmo. I transfer \$20 dollars a month to my Homegroup. The Homegroup Treasurer checks the balance of the Groups Venmo account. They transfer that money to the Area Treasurer's Venmo account and the Area Treasurer deposits all of the donations as one lump sum amount to the Area bank account for a max fee of \$10.00.

Here is a picture of the transaction screen you fill out to send your Venmo payment.



So you want to know how it will benefit your group? What if I forget my wallet or am not carrying cash? Your group doesn't get a donation from me that week because I didn't have cash to put in the basket. But with Venmo you can pay later and not need to carry cash. The northern Tier countries of Norway, Sweden and Denmark are using Venmo to accept payments in major cities and have seen a 29% increase in NA donations to their groups over a 3 year period and that number is rising. Information was provided on this topic by the world board at MZSSNA and can be found at NA.ORG.

Sending money to a group via Venmo:

Using Venmo to pay your 7th tradition because you don't always carry cash.

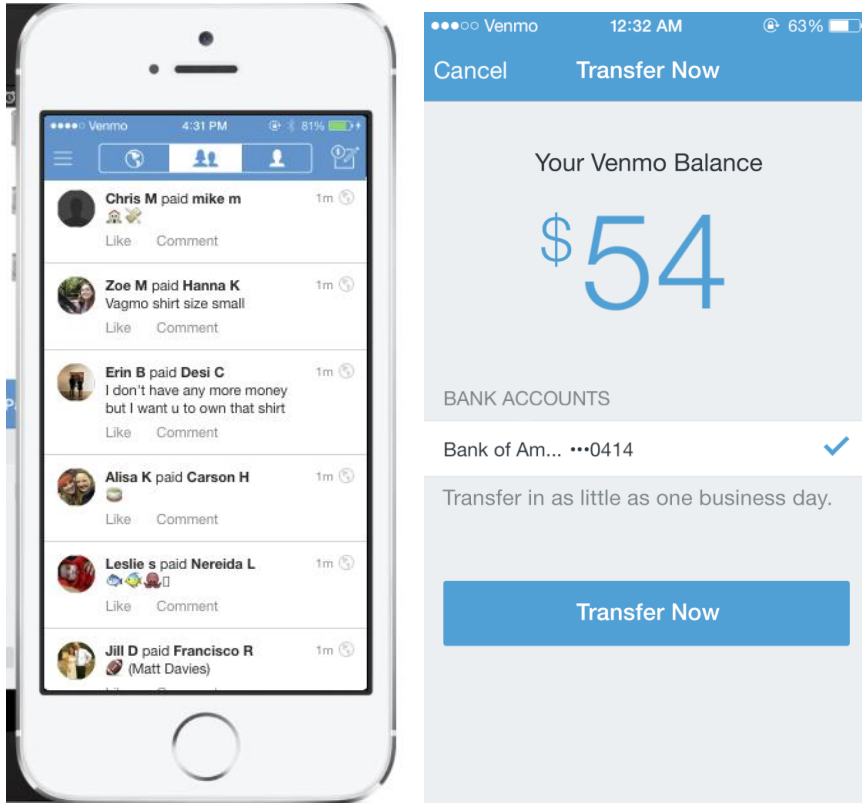
To Pay your 7th tradition using Venmo. Send money using Venmo is free using a bank account, Venmo account, or Debit card however, a 3% fee still applies when a credit card is used to send money.

So it costs you nothing to use Venmo to send money to a group unless your using a credit card. You can pay as many times as you like Venmo account to Venmo account for nothing when you use a bank account, debit card or your Venmo balance. You can set it up on auto draft and pay once a week or once a month a set amount from your Venmo account or bank account or debit card for a zero-dollar charge.

Depositing your groups 7th tradition from your Venmo Account to your groups Bank account:

Our standard transfer service is free to use. Meaning the money will transfer in 1-3 business days for zero fees. A fee of 1% of the transfer amount (minimum fee \$0.25, maximum fee \$10) will be deducted from the transfer amount for each Instant Transfer which will arrive in 10 minutes to your bank account. Below are pictures that show you

what the ledger of your account looks like. You can go to any home computer and print the ledger to keep for your records.

How Venmo helps protect your financial information

We use encryption to help protect your account information and monitor your account activity to help identify unauthorized transactions. If you suspect that your account shows unauthorized activity, contact us.

Encryption & storage: We use encryption to help protect your account details and store that information on servers in secure locations. On the web, "https:" and a lock next to the web address is your signal that encryption is on.

Account protection :If you've lost your phone or suspect that it is being used in an unauthorized way, you can prevent your phone from accessing your Venmo account. Just go to Venmo.com > Settings > Security and remove the session associated with your phone. When you remove the session, you'll be signed out of the app on your phone.

To add additional layers of security to your Venmo account, set up multifactor authentication and add a PIN code in the app.

Keep yourself safe: Venmo is designed for payments between friends and people who trust each other. Avoid payments to people you don't know, especially if it involves a sale for goods and services (like event tickets and Craigslist items).
